
Church Unbound meets every Sunday, rain or shine.

Join us St. Mark's following Evening Prayer 7/24 and 7/31 to view the 2006 film, *Amazing Grace*. We'll watch the first half of the film on July 24th and finish it up on July 31st. *Amazing Grace* is a 2006 biographical drama film, about the abolitionist campaign against the slave trade in the British Empire, led by [William Wilberforce](#). The title is a reference to the 1772 [hymn "Amazing Grace"](#), which was written by [John Newton](#), a captain of slave ships who underwent a Christian conversion and became a major influence on Wilberforce and the abolition movement.

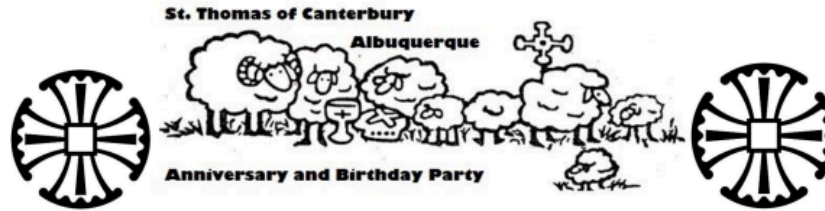
